

OFFICIAL COVID-19 REGULATION FOR THE PROKART ESTONIA, STAGE 4

3.09 – 4.09.2021

1.2.1 According to the regulation nr 282 by the Republic of Estonia from 27.08.2021 (found on: <https://www.riigiteataja.ee/akt/306082021002?leiaKehtiv>) any person will be allowed into the paddock only with an electronic or printed certificate which proves that the person:

1.2.1.1 has been diagnosed with COVID-19 before and it has not been longer than 180 days ago.

1.2.1.2 has been fully vaccinated against COVID 19.

1.2.1.3 has a valid antigen-RTD test not older than 48h when arriving in the paddock.

1.2.1.4 has a valid negative PCR test not older than 72h when arriving in the paddock.

1.2.2 Presentation of a certificate is not necessary under the age of 18.

1.2.3 In case of suspicion of forgery, the person must present their document (passport or ID).

1.2.4 In case a person doesn't have or refuses to present one of the following certificates in point 1.2.1 (or doesn't wear a COVID-safe wristband 1.2.5) the person **will not be allowed in the paddock**. A fee for intentionally breaking any rules mentioned above will be **1 000 euros**. According to Estonian Karting Sporting Regulation point 2.9, **the entrant of each competitor has the responsibility** over their drivers to follow the regulations above.

1.2.5 Wristbands will be given to the people who hand in a valid electronic or printed certification and they are mandatory to wear throughout the whole race weekend.

1.2.6 The organizer doesn't provide any testing opportunity on site.
